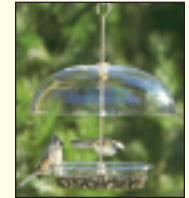
### The New Laurentian Feeder

important to birds than a good food supply. Just plug it in and watch the birds flock to your yard. Great gift idea for the person who has (almost) everything!

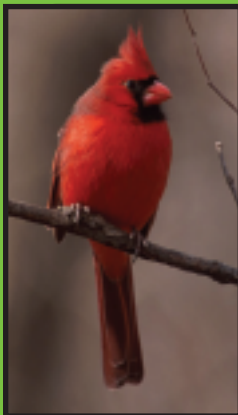
### Miniblossom Hummingbird Feeder

### A FEW FUN FACTS ABOUT THE **CARDINAL**

The Northern Cardinal gets its name from the cardinals of the Roman Catholic Church who wear red robes and hats.

The male is the only all-red bird with a crest, which makes identification foolproof. The female has buffy-rose plumage with reddish wings and tail and is one of the few female birds that actually sings.

The oldest re-captured banded Northern Cardinal was still alive at 15 years and 9 months old.

Cardinals mate for life. They usually remain together through the winter, often joining with a few others to form loose flocks.

Cardinals are usually the first birds to arrive at the birdfeeder in early morning and the last to visit at dusk. They prefer those feeding stations that offer seed on a tray, platform or on the ground. Although they love sunflower seed, they do eat a variety of other foods, such as safflower seed, cut corn and peanuts.
